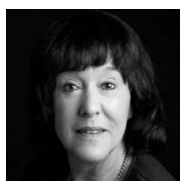


SPEECH & DRAMA

She teaches speech, drama, musical theatre, mime and dance drama to all ages of students, including adults and specialises in the LAMDA examinations. The Marking Category System

Dev	Developing	A performance demonstrating an awareness of technical skills, requiring more consistency & artistry.
Prog	Progressing	A performance showing development of technique and/or communication and commitment.
Mer	Merit	A competent performance, showing some artistic awareness and/or technical ability.
Com	Commended	A convincing performance technically & artistically, with increasing stylistic & communication skills.
Hon	Honours	An excellent performance, demonstrating fluent technical and artistic skills with emerging individuality.
Ots	Outstanding	An impressive performance technically and artistically, displaying spontaneity & clear individuality.
Exc	Exceptional	A superlative performance, displaying exceptional artistic individuality.
